Meeting called to order at 6.55 pm

1. Approval of minutes from May 4, 2023

 - We still have to set up Heidy, via phone conference
- Boat trip was booked out, no need to post any longer

- Auggie did talk to Hugo Baumann about Cedric, will maybe set up an additional chat

3. General remarks by the president

- Ambassador Olaf Kjelsen is going to be in Toronto on Jun 21, 2023 3:20 p.m., at Cafe Landwer
- National day:
 - Trillium is going to play at National Day, asking for \$450
 - New band: Golden Keys, we don't know how expensive yet
 - Canadysli will play
 - Swiss Citizen of the year: Marc Lurz (and he'll be there)
 - Consul General Line Leon-Pernet is attending
 - The official speech from Switzerland was read out last time, maybe get an audio clip and hook it up to our speaker? Then again, the Consul General is already speaking, maybe that's sufficient?
 - Still need to find sponsors and volunteers
 - Debbie and Marcus Werner, plus more Werner family

4. Treasurer's report

- Bank account is done, Albert officially retired from signing
- Need to add Heidy
- Need to make a test e-Transfer payment
- Membership payments are trickling in, lots of cheques today
- Expenses since last time about \$1400, including locker, Zoom

Amended via email after meeting:

• Ben is now a signing officer

- Online access "view only" is set up and active for Auggie
- Receiving e-Transfers is enabled and has been successfully tested with autodeposit: when someone makes an email transfer to us, both the notification and transaction on the bank account will display the sender's name (email address)
- Cheques issued by the club still require two authorized signatures (unchanged)
- ATM cards don't allow withdrawals, only deposits; we don't have credit cards for the club and can't make outbound e-Transfers
- If a supplier or service provider that wants to be paid by credit card or email transfer... The workaround continues to be:
 - A club officer makes the payment using their own personal account or credit card, then asks the club for reimbursement (via cheque signed by 2 authorized signatories)
 - In practice that applies to our routine Storage Locker, Zoom and also Pickle Barrel and others that are less frequent.
- Email / e-Transfer: we can finally accept email transfers sent to finance@swissclubtoronto.ca and they will be automatically deposited.
- The practical implications are where we collect money: i.e membership dues and certain events:
 - Some members may choose to pay their dues by e-transfer rather than cheque or credit card. For the club this is much more convenient than cheques and cheaper than credit card (because credit card fees mean that for a \$40 membership renewal by credit card, the club only receives \$38.58)
 - At events like Swiss National Day, if a participant feels like buying, say \$100 worth of raffle tickets, but doesn't have that amount of physical cash on them ... they could email us and the treasurer could see the payment right away. "there's no excuse for not buying raffle tickets such as "I don't have cash", "need to go to the nearest bank"
 - Other Club events to be determined. Last year in December we had a fondue event at a restaurant, where the club/Nadia collected funds from the participants and then paid the restaurant. This would be much easier if participants can pay the club directly by email.
 - Section events like Raclette, Theatre, Men at Egger Farm or Canadysli dinner and dance are NOT affected by the changes to the club account, because those go through the individual sections' cash and accounts rather than the club.

- New lifetime member: Madelaine Muller
- Richards-Traber family enquired about lifetime membership for the late Hans Traber; lifetime memberships were introduced after his passing. Ben will reach out to offer lifetime membership to the family if they qualify

- Payment reminder emails have been updated to say that a cheque might be in our P.O. box, just not deposited yet
- A few members have reached out about their cheques; all of their cheques were in today's pile
- Somebody pointed out that the link to "Terms & Conditions" when paying with credit card on the website is dead
