Canada Post processes 37 million pieces of mail *each day*, 11 billion per year and sends them to 14 million addresses. Contrary to popular belief, 96.8% of all mail is delivered within service targets of 1 to 4 days, depending on distance.

I did this tour in June with another group and can only tell you that it was *extremely interesting*. One condition—no open-toed footwear is allowed. Regular shoes or running shoes are ok. *Please register with me*.
