





# From the Consulate General of Switzerland

Dear Swiss Compatriots

## In most places, e-mail is quicker than the traditional post

For the Consulate General of Switzerland in Toronto where you are registered and for the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA), direct communication with you is important, and in this respect Internet and e-mail are increasingly becoming the quickest and most reliable way of contact. However the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection does not allow us to use your e-mail address unless we have your agreement to do so.

Being able to inform you quickly and easily about matters that could be of interest to you or in case of an emergency (e.g. natural disaster in the consular district) is of utmost importance to us. By registering on the website <a href="www.swissabroad.ch">www.swissabroad.ch</a> you will not only allow us to get in touch with you quickly and easily but you will also be able to check and update your contact information, while choosing the way you want to receive your copy of the *Swiss Review* (electronic or paper form).

In this regard please note that as of 2010, the *Swiss Review* will be delivered electronically to all Swiss citizens abroad registered on www.swissabroad.ch who did not specify that they wish to receive the review in the paper form. Also, all households which have so far received several copies of the "Swiss Review" to the same postal address will only get one copy in the future.

If you do not have an e-mail address or if you choose not to register you shall continue to receive our information as well as the "Swiss Review" in your mailbox as before.

Help us to get in touch with you the quickest and easiest way by registering on www.swissabroad.ch. Thank you!

What your consent is all about: With the disclosure of your e-mail address, you allow until your further notice the Consulate General of Switzerland and the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) to use your electronic address for official correspondence. Further, you agree to inform your representation of any changes to your electronic and mailing addresses. The personal information including the e-mail-address you are providing to us are protected by the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (DSG, SR 235.1) and will not be divulged to others.



Please note that the new opening hours of the Chancery at the Consulate General of Switzerland in Toronto are from Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
